

COURSE J4/16

START

At a 'JS14' mark in Twemlow Lane, just before a property called 'Timbers' and directly opposite a power pole (numbered 06/0939/6). Proceed east to the A535 at

TWEMLOW GREEN

1.259 m

Where turn left onto the A535 to:

CHELFORD ISLAND

5.869 m

Take 2nd exit left onto the A537 to:

BOOTHS HALL ISLAND

9.904 m

Left into Goughs Lane to the A50 where turn left along A50 to:

CRANAGE

16.104 m

Turn left into Twemlow Lane past the start to commence a second lap. Proceed to:

TWEMLOW GREEN

18.222 m

Where turn left onto the A535 to:

CHELFORD ISLAND

22.832 m

Take 2nd exit left onto the A537 to:

BOOTHS HALL ISLAND

26.867 m

Left into Goughs Lane to the A50 where turn left along A50 to:

CRANAGE

33.118 m

Turn left into Twemlow Lane past the start to commence a third lap:

TWEMLOW GREEN

35.185 m

Where turn left onto the A535 to:

CHELFORD ISLAND

39.795 m

Take 2nd exit left onto the A537 to:

BOOTHS HALL ISLAND

43.830 m

Left into Goughs Lane to the A50 where turn left along A50 to:

FINISH

50.000 m

At a 'JF14' mark on the A50 opposite a small 50mph sign 2 yards beyond an iron field gate but before 'Plum Tree Farm' approx. 150 yards short of Twemlow Lane.

Riders must exercise caution at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification from the event and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

A competitor who swings out to the right before executing a left turn should ensure that the road behind is clear of traffic before doing so. The practice is not encouraged by the District Committee and competitors who ride in this manner are warned that in many circumstances this manoeuvre will be regarded as a contravention of regulation 47 (i),(iii),(v).

Riders must not perform U turns in the vicinity of the start or finish of the event. Riders observed performing U turns will be reported to the District Committee who will consider disciplinary proceedings.

Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders MUST NOT approach and encircle the island using tri-bars. Remember - traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Be aware that there is a double bend shortly after turning into Twemlow Lane at Cranage. Riders need to anticipate this and be prepared to negotiate it in a safe manner. In wet weather the metal covers and edges become a skid risk. Please take care.

Turn left out of the headquarters onto the A50, take the first right onto Twemlow Lane. The start is approx. 0.5m down Twemlow Lane.

No competitors (or supporters) vehicles are allowed at the start or the finish.
