Start

In Bomish Lane (Badger Bank to Goostrey road) at a "J4/16e" surveyors disc opposite 2nd gate post of field gate on other side of road and approx.. 150yds west of the A535. Proceed east to the A535, and forward on the A535 to:-

Booths Hall Island Left along Goughs Lane to the A50 at:-	<u>6.097 m</u>
<u>Toft</u> Left along the A50 to:-	<u>6.656 m</u>
<u>Cranage</u> Left along Twemlow Lane though the Start and continue as before to the A535 Twemlow Green where left along the A535 to:-	<u>12.403 m</u>
Chelford Island 2 nd exit left on the A547 to:-	<u>19.025 m</u>
<u>Booths Hall Island</u> Left along Goughs Lane to join the A50 at:-	<u>23.06 m</u>
<u>Toft</u> Left along the A50 to:-	<u>23.619 m</u>
<u>Cranage</u> Left along Twemlow Lane to Twemlow Green where left along the A535 to:-	<u>29.366 m</u>
<u>Chelford Island</u> 2 nd exit left along the A537 to:-	<u>35.978 m</u>
Booths Hall Island Left along Goughs Lane to:-	<u>40.023 m</u>
Toft Left along the A50 to:-	<u>40.582 m</u>
Cranage Left along Twemlow Lane to Twemlow Green where left along the A535 to:-	<u>46.329 m</u>
Finish At a "J4/16e" surveyors disc on the A535 adjacent to power pole no "DP8" & opp Lane junction. Just past Jodrell Bank rear entrance.	50.033 m posite Farm

NOTES

- 1 Riders should follow direction signs from the HQ to the start.
- 2 Riders must continue to Bomish Lane and follow signed route back to HQ after finishing so as not to add to any congestion at Chelford Island.
- 3 Under no circumstances are riders to stop or U-turn after the finish.

RACE NUMBERS AT HEADQUARTERS

Riders are required to sign the CTT signing on sheet when collecting & returning their numbers at the HQ.

The HQ is approx. 2.9m from the start at Marthall Village Hall, Sandlebridge La, Knutsford WA16 7SB (map ref. SJ800758).

Directions to the start: Turn L out of the HQ, cross the A537 (carefully) into Sandhole Lane. Continue along Snelson Lane. Cross over Pepper Street onto Mill Lane. Follow Mill Lane and Boundary Lane to turn L into Bate Mill Road. At a T junction turn L into Bomish Lane for approx. 100 yds to the start. The route to the start and back to the HQ after the finish will be signposted.

No competitors (or supporters) vehicles are allowed at the start or the finish.

Riders must exercise caution at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification from the event and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

Please take special care at the Gough's Lane/A50 junction, and at both ends of Twemlow Lane. Marshals have been asked to note any riders crossing white lines into the oncoming carriageway. Offending riders reported to the organiser will be disqualified from the event.

A competitor who swings out to the right before executing a left turn should ensure that the road behind is clear of traffic before doing so. The practice is not encouraged by the District Committee and competitors who ride in this manner are warned that in many circumstances this manoeuvre will be regarded as a contravention of regulation 47 (i),(iii),(v).

Riders must not perform U turns in the vicinity of the start or finish of the event. Riders observed performing U turns will be reported to the District Committee who will consider disciplinary proceedings. Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders MUST NOT approach and encircle the island using tri-bars. <u>Remember - traffic on the island has</u> <u>priority over traffic (including riders) entering it.</u> Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Be aware that there is a double bend shortly after turning into Twemlow Lane at Cranage. Riders need to anticipate this and be prepared to negotiate it in a safe manner.

In wet weather the metal covers and edges become a skid risk. Please take care.
